

Knights Templar Scholarship Award

Application deadline June 1st of each year.

The Knights Templar Educational Foundation has instituted a scholarship program providing grants up to \$5,000.00* per year. These scholarships are for students accepted or enrolled in a program leading to an associate, bachelor, master, doctoral, or professional degree, or certified technical or vocational programs**.

Students must have maintained a B average (3.0 or better) for the year prior to applying for a scholarship.

Applications will not be considered without all needed material. **Transcripts must be mailed directly from the academic institution and letters of reference mailed directly by the submitter, not the applicant.**

Awards are made for one academic year, and recipients are eligible for not more than two awards.

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- Exhibit exceptional efforts in community service
- Have graduated from a Maryland high school
- Parents/guardian reside in Maryland
- Must have maintained a B average (3.0 or better) for the year prior to applying for a scholarship
- Submit proof of full-time post-secondary school program (college or technical)
- Submit two character references from community/work
- Submit two school references from current teachers

Selection Method

- The Knights Templar Division Education Foundation Committee will review all applications and select the finalists.
- The committee may interview applicants before final selection.
- Applicants will be notified in writing of the committee's decisions.
- Efforts will be made to honor the Scholarship winners with the scholarship award given at a reception held around the last full weekend in October. The Scholarship winners are encouraged to attend to receive their award.

Application for Student Grant (Read Carefully)

1. Grants may be awarded for vocational, professional training, advanced degree, or post-graduate work, with the approval of the Grand Commander of Maryland Knight Templar Educational Foundation Committee.
2. Grants Criteria: Scholarships or Fellowships will only be granted to encourage young men/women of outstanding ability and promise to procure a technical, college or post-graduate education. Grants will be open to all students regardless of their financial circumstances. The recipient of a Knights Templar Educational Foundation (KTEF) Scholarship/Fellowship should be distinguished as young men/women of outstanding intellectual promise, high attainment, high moral character and responsibility, who have the potential to render service to their church and nation.
3. You must be found personally worthy after investigation by the Committee.
4. The maximum grant to any one student shall be determined by the KTEF Committee. No more than two grants shall be given to any one person.
5. Your personal/character references (two) must be a citizen and a resident of your Maryland hometown. One reference must come from your home church/religious organization **OR** from an individual who can address your moral character. (Form 2)
6. Of your instructors (two), given as references, one must be the one who has had supervision over and observation of your work in the last two years of your school attendance. (Form 3)
7. A copy of your transcript (sent directly from your school) and a personal photograph (at least 2 X 4 size or larger) must be submitted with your application.
8. After reading these instructions carefully, pages 4 and 5 are to be filled out, signed by the applicant, and then return the application to KTEF at the address shown on page 1.
