2026 Educational Scholarships

The Tall Cedars of Lebanon International will award five \$1,000 Scholarships for a one-year period according to the following criteria:

A. Awarded annually to a member in good standing of a Job's Daughters Bethel, a Rainbow Assembly, or a DeMolay Chapter in a jurisdiction where a Tall Cedar Forest exists, or be the son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter of a Tall Cedar in good standing. Previous recipients are not eligible. The jurisdictions where Tall Cedar Forests are located are as follows:

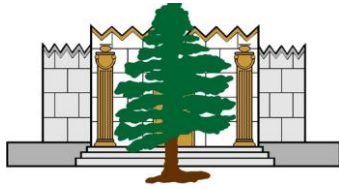
B. Each candidate must:

1. Be accepted, or completed the first year, at an accredited institution in any Associate Degree, Baccalaureate Degree, Technical or Vocation Program;
2. Plan to attend on a full-time basis;
3. Be of excellent character, personal integrity, leadership, and community involvement;
4. Provide two recommendations from school administrators, guidance counselors, and/or teachers;
5. Provide one personal reference;
6. Provide financial need information;
7. Complete a personal essay of no more than 1,000 words outlining why education is important to themselves;
8. Submit an official school transcript;
9. Complete the Masonic Affiliation form; and
10. Complete a photo/video release form.

C. Deadline for all applications is March 31st, with the awards being made prior to April 30th.

D. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to the selected candidates.

All components of the application are available through the Supreme Forest office (see contact information, above) and must be submitted in one package to the Scholarship Chairman at the above address.



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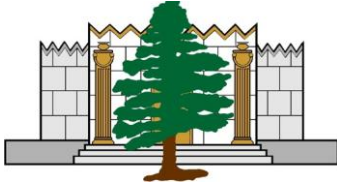

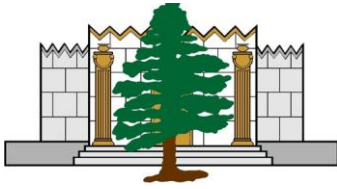

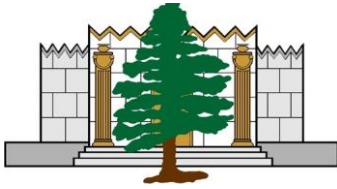
